Wells:

• 975 Chequessett Neck Road, Wellfleet MA (Map #19, Parcel #96)

995 Chequessett Neck Road, Wellfleet MA (Map #19, Parcel #95)
 Both properties were discussed together and are in need of moving the wells across the street. Picariello questioned the water test, Lemos stated she has seen the water test and approves

Drohan moved to grant the variance to regulation 504 to have the properties wells be moved across the street in order to get potable water. Locke seconded the motion, motion carried 4-0

Septic:

• 1305 State Highway, Wellfleet MA (Map #30, Parcel #159) ~ Thornton Ellis presented to the board, stating he would like to put in a new 1500-gallon tank with a new leach area. He is asking for 3 variances. The board questioned Lemos if she had any issues with this plan. Lemos stated she didn't have any issues.

Drohan moved to approve the J.C. Ellis plan dated December 3, 2020 and grant the four variances requested in the letter November 29, 2020 for the upgrade of a septic system to serve a four-bedroom dwelling, using Advantex AX-20 denitrification technology under the general use approval category. Subject to the following conditions:

Design flow to be limited to 454 GPD

No increase in habitable area without Board of Health review

No conversion of use without Board of Health review

Well water is to be tested

Deed recording to be done at the Barnstable Registry of Deeds

IA monitoring to be done

Picariello seconded the motion, motion carried 4-0

Shellfish Relay
