#### **Whitewater Report (Jonathan Preissler)**

- **Status of Generator Repairs at Boy Scout Camp Well Field**

Voltage regulator replaced. The generator is still shutting off. They will have to do a load test by South Shore Generator and will need to diagnose the problem. They should be out soon to do the diagnoses.

Well #2 is down. A new VFD ordered and will be installed when it arrives by Cape Water Sources. The motor was replaced, now it will be the VFD to be replaced. The quote was \$3200.00 to replace the VFD. The generator had issues during the last storm. Coolant level sensor was shutting off the generator every time it was suppose to run. That was corrected.
- **Status of water main installation**

Jonathan stops out every week to check on the installation. Currently they are working on Briar Lane, Digit and inspector from EPG. There is approximately 1800 ft installed. They should be done later this week. No issues so far. They will move to Old Hay Rd and working towards Coles Neck Station. Who is the resident inspector from EP his name is Chris.
- **Scope of Work at Coles Neck Well Field**

Whitewater running the wells, and flushing the well for the past month and a half. TC samples came back clean no problems. PFSA samples will be taken there next. Seasonal startup and do another inspection, take more bacteria sampling again and then submit all the paperwork to DEP. May need a new generator, which was installed in 2010.
