Chair Magee asked John Riehl to speak about Article 26 Wellfleet Harbor Flora and Fauna Survey. The Article will be delayed until the fall and not be on the Warrant on Saturday. John will come back with a summary when it is closer to the time when FINCOM needs to vote on it. (Sometime in the fall).

### Discussion with Town Administrator Charlie Sumner

Charlies Sumner will speak on the details of the Operating Budget. There will be an increase of \$2000 in Town Administrator's expenses. Reserve fund did not exist and needed to be funded, \$89,500 for Finance Committee. There was also an increase in Shellfish Salaries for increase \$8255. DPW Facilities increase \$8200. The total would be \$21,781,663. The previous Town Accountant planned on using Beach Funds to subitize approx. \$1M from the Beach Fund. White Crest Beach was closed during COVID which was a large loss of funds not available to subitize the budget. Recommending that we use Stabilization Fund to the amount of \$514,200. (Due to shortfall from Beach Funds). There is an approximate 14% increase in tax levy on property taxes if everything gets approved on the new overrides on the Warrant along with operating budget and debt budget get approved.

There would be a fall Town meeting with reconciliation. Looking at free cash to assist with Stabilization Fund. Goal is to have free cash certified by the end of September with a late October Town Meeting. Get fall taxes bills out in a timely matter to assist with cash flow.
