

WELLFLEET HISTORICAL COMMISSION 300 Main Street – Town Hall Wellfleet, Massachusetts 02667

The Wellfleet Historical Commission met on November 4, 2020 remotely via Zoom. Members Present: Lydia Vivante, Merrill Mead-Fox, Tom Siggia, Carol Ubriaco. Lucas Manning. Also Present: Eva Erickson, Andrew Erickson, Jack Wishart, John Tritle

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm.

- 1. <u>50 West Main Street:</u> Jack Wishart presented a proposal for a laundry addition in the "U" formed by three sides of the building. The footprint is out of view of the street. The proposal was approved 5-0.
- 2. <u>135 Commercial Street</u>: Discussion of changes to a 1950 addition. Ms Mead-Fox moved to approve the proposal to reposition and replace the windows and door and replace the chimney on the 1950 addition. Ms. Ubriaco seconded the motion; Mr. Manning recused himself. The motion was passed 4-0.

The Ericksons also proposed the replacement of the existing deck with black steel columns supporting a wooden deck with wire railings. The purpose of the wire railings is to lessen its visibility. A structural engineer will determine if the 1950 addition's roof will be able to support the deck. Railing system options will be reviewed at a future meeting.

- 3. <u>Planning Board Review of 20 Briar Lane</u>: Ms. Mead-Fox and Ms. Ubriaco will attend the Zoom meeting that evening.
- 4. <u>Community Preservation Needs List:</u> Ms. Ubriaco will check out the availability of historical information at the Wellfleet Historical Society & Museum regarding the railroad, the saltworks and shipbuilding to see if these topics should continue to remain on the list.
- 5. <u>Form B Historic Property Inventory Project Update:</u> Alice Iacuessa and Maria Burks have proofread their Form Bs, and they will be forwarded to Mr. Siggia.
- 6. <u>New WHC Instagram:</u> Ms. Mead-Fox presented the first pages of the new account. Mr. Manning will send photos which can be used to show construction in historic buildings.

- 7. Ms. Vivante moved and Mr. Manning seconded the approval of the minutes of Sept. 24, October 7, and October 22. The minutes were approved 5-0.
- 8. Mr. Siggia said that the treasurer's report had not changed since the report at the last meeting.

It was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 pm.
