

## WELLFLEET HISTORICAL COMMISSION 300 Main Street – Town Hall Wellfleet, Massachusetts 02667

The Wellfleet Historical Commission met in the Wellfleet Public Library meeting room on December 4, 2019. Members present: Anne Freyss, Luke Manning, Tom Siggia, Carol Ubriaco and Lydia Vivante. Members absent: Merrill-Mead Fox and Nick Watkins. Also present: Bruce Biehrens, Nathaniel Cook, Diane Addison and Abe Boyle of My Generation Energy, Janet Lesniak, Justin Post and Marla Rice. Chair Vivante opened the meeting at 5:02 pm.

- 1. <u>25 Emily's Lane</u>: Tom Siggia seconded Freyss' motion to approve the application for screened porch replacement. The vote to approve was unanimous.
- 2. <u>335 Main Street, Preservation Hall</u>: A presentation by Lesniak, Rice and Biehrens for replacement of the slate roof and solar panel installation prompted a lengthy discussion. Finally, Vivante made a motion, with Freyss' second, to ask Sarah Korjeff of the Cape Cod Commission for an advisory opinion before any final decision regarding this proposal. The motion passed 4-1, with Manning abstaining.
- 3. Vivante reported on her attendance (with Freyss) at the Regional Historical Commissions Roundtable meeting in November.
- 4. Historic Preservation Plan updates: With a balance of \$23,700 in the Treasury, it was agreed to purchase an IPad and keyboard for the Commissioners' use.
- 5. Annual report is due in January as well as any Town Meeting articles. Siggia moved with Freyss seconding his proposal to send a letter the CPC supporting the Historical Society's request for Phase II funds. The vote was unanimously in favor of doing so.
- 6. Vivante mentioned that we need to revise the application form in light of the non-compliance issues of late.
- 7. It was duly moved and seconded and voted unanimously to approve the minutes of November 6, 2019 as printed.
