Charge

Grout Thomas suggested the charge be "To update the 2008 Local Comprehensive Plan in accordance with Cape Cod Commission's Regional Policy Plan framework and take it though the process for ultimate acceptance by the Commission and Town Meeting."

Mission Statement

There was discussion about mission versus vision statements.

Norton shared his vision statements for each placetype and which predetermined segments fit into each. The predetermined segments and Cape Cod Commission Placetypes are as follows:

Wellfleet Segments:

- 1. Natural Resources, Ground Water, Ponds, Harbors, Beaches
- 2. Land Use
- 3. Herring River Restoration
- 4. Open Space
- 5. Economic Vitality
- 6. Community Facilities and Resources
- 7. Community Housing
- 8. Wellfleet Historic Preservation/Community Character
- 9. Human and Health Services and Resources
- 10. Energy and Climate Action
- 11. Shellfishing
- 12. Harbor and Marina

Cape Cod Commission Placetypes:

- 1. Natural areas
- 2. Rural Development Areas
- 3. Historic Areas
- 4. Maritime Areas
- 5. Community Activity Centers

6. Light Industrial Activity Centers

The group decided to add a 7th placetype – Economic Vitality Areas/Areas of Economic Vitality.

Plaue noted that the goal for each placetype is to protect what we have currently and determine how to grow it.

For the next meeting, the group will work on goals for each placetype.

Butler shared her draft mission statement, in short and long form:

Option 1

Through collaboration with its residents and business community the Town will ensure, with its rich history and natural resources, that it fulfills the needs of the community by fostering an environment for responsible growth by means of providing a variety of housing, business, cultural and recreational opportunities in a safe, sustainable and attractive environment.

Option 2

The Town of Wellfleet is committed to ensuring, with its rich history and natural resources, that it fulfills the needs of the community by fostering an environment for responsible growth by means of providing a variety of housing, business, cultural and recreational opportunities in a safe, sustainable and attractive environment.

The group unanimously agreed that these were a good mission statement and to vote on which one to adopt at a further meeting.

There was further discussion about placetype organization, goals, and vision.
