# **Dredging Update**

Joe and John provided an update from the January 9, 2023, Dredging Task Force Meeting. Curt Felix and Joe from the Task Force along with town officials met with personnel with the Army Corps of Engineers regarding securing the required dredging permit. The Corps is still requiring mitigation in lieu of a cash payment. The Corps agreed to consider a town plan of utilizing the waters west of the herring River Dike to be used for shellfishing and the town will provide them with some documentation.

#### **Marina Concerns**

Several members expressed concern about the danger of leaving the gangway entrance to the fuel dock open as the gangway is removed.

#### **Marina Parking**

Members participated in a lengthy discussion about various possible components for a marina parking plan. Reserving 73 spaces along the guardrail for boaters, utilizing a kiosk system, providing a shuttle service, charging a fee and utilizing a sticker system.

The following motion was made by Doug and seconded by David. That the seventy three parking spaces along the marina east guardrail by the boat slips be reserved for boat owners daily from 9:00am to 7:00pm. This parking rule would be in effect from the third week in June to Labor Day. Motion passed unanimously.
