Members of NRAB made a special effort this summer to visit and monitor Wellfleet great ponds. There is good evidence of progress

in vegetative restoration and in parking management. We appreciate all the good work that has been done by your office and others.

However, ponds use is still at a very high level.

The parking attendants at the ponds were observed by several of us to be absent in the latter part of the afternoon. The result was a significant

increase in late afternoon ponds use, especially at Gull and Long Ponds.

It remains part of the NRAB pond strategy to keep ponds use at a reliably managed level in order to help protect the long term health of these important Town features.

We recommend a three year trial that ensures parking attendants in place until at least 5 pm ... and preferably 6 pm ... throughout the summer season.

We recognize that there would be an increased cost to implement this initiative. We are writing now so that this cost could be included in next years budget.
