NRAB - Harbor study (Curley Report), New Charter

J. Riehl reviewed the change to their New Charter. Their charter was approved in 1987. The wording was not clear as it relates to their working with SAB. Their new charter reflects the current working relationship with the SAB.

J.Riehl asked our board for input into the Harbor Study. We discussed agriculture and cultching areas, new reefs and the wild. Compare areas that are not being used to areas that the shellfish community is using. Also nitrogen reduction in harbor and the benefits shellfishing in harbor.

Shellfish Department – Signs
