

Bulky Items • carpets • mattresses • TVs • computer monitors (see e-waste) • large appliances • large furniture

Scrap Metal all metal (except for tin and aluminum cans)

Demolition • brick • concrete • rock • sand • dirt • painted wood • window glass • clean gypsum wallboard

Marine Debris • plastic netting • rope

Mercury • compact fluorescent bulbs (CFLs) • fluorescent tubing • thermometers • thermostats • cell phone batteries • button batteries • rechargeable batteries • car batteries *Note: It is illegal to throw mercury in the trash.*

Mixed Paper

- Milk, juice, soup cartons
- Egg cartons
- Cardboard and empty pizza boxes
- Cereal boxes
- Home and office paper, letters, envelopes, file folders. Junk mail, catalogs, phonebooks
- Newspapers and magazines
- Paper clips, staples, spiral bindings, plastic tape, cellophane windows are OK!
Please, no plastic foil pouches. Buy juice boxes or refill a reusable container instead

Plastic and Metal Recyclables

Tin, steel, aluminum cans • Plastic containers, caps and lids. No need to remove paper labels

- Rigid Plastics including plastic toys, buckets, chairs, flower pots, etc.
- Styrofoam: please see attendant or check with your local Pack & Ship store

Returnable Cans and Plastic Bottles

- Please sort in the returnables area

Glass • Bottles and jars only

No broken glass, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, glassware or ceramics

Textiles 95% of textiles are recyclable. Place clean & dry items in the collection boxes or donate to local thrifts & animal shelters
