TOWN OF WELLFLEET  
REPAIR OF WELLFLEET TRANSFER STATION

The Town of Wellfleet is accepting sealed bids to remove existing metal siding, metal roofing and girts; clean and paint structural frame; and replace girts, metal siding and roofing with new materials at the Department of Public Works Solid Waste Transfer Station Building at 370 Coles Neck Road, Wellfleet.

Vendors who download the bid specs from the town website are required to contact the Assistant Public Works Director by email so they may be advised of any bid addenda. Sealed bids submitted in duplicated and clearly marked "**Repair of Wellfleet Transfer Station**" will be accepted by the Town Administrator at 300 Main Street, Wellfleet, MA 02667 until 2:00PM of August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, treasure's or cashier's check, payable to the Town of Wellfleet, Massachusetts is required in a dollar amount of five (5) percent of the bid amount.

The Instructions to Bidders, Form of General Bid, Contract, Specifications, Performance and Payment Bond, and other Contract Documents may be examined, obtained, or mailed from the Assistant Public Works Director's office from Monday through Friday 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM. To request mailing, call (508) 349-0315.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including General Law Chapter 149. Wage rates are subject to the minimum wage rates as per M.G.L. Chapter 149, Section 265 to 270 inclusive.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100% Payment Bond and 100% Performance Bond with a surety company acceptable to the Owner. Complete instructions for filing bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of thirty days, Saturdays and Sundays and Legal Holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids. The Town of Wellfleet through its Board of Selectmen reserves the right to waive any informality and to reject any or all bids if it is in the best interest of the Town of Wellfleet to do so.
