Historic character is vital to Wellfleet's economy, and protecting that character is largely in the hands of private property owners, who also benefit from it. However, commission members have encountered quite a few project proponents, appearing before the commission for project review, who are unaware of the demolition delay bylaw and could use a hand understanding some of the historic features and character of their properties. The workshop is a good opportunity to get questions asked and answered.
