- 1) 3152 State Highway Route 6 Main Street (1842): Proposal to replace eight original wood windows with Renewal by Anderson windows. (Presenter: Jake Roberts from Renewal by Anderson; Property owner: Kathleen Matthews)
- 2). 130 School Street (c. 1820): This building is located within Wellfleet Center's National Register District. Proposal to modify exterior rear elevation of middle barn as follows: 1. Eliminate existing 30"x77" rear door, 2. Eliminate existing 12 over 12 40"x 62" window, 3. Add six additional 6 over 6 28"x 42 3/4" windows mulled in triplets (Presenters/Owners: Brian Uy and Doriot Kim).
- 3) 2483 State Highway Route 6 (ca. 1880): Letter from the Massachusetts Department of Transportation requesting that the MHC find their Route 6 project to have "No Adverse Effect" on historic properties in Wellfleet. The southern expansion of the Route 6 project is just within the historically inventoried Chipman's Cove area, and this property is located within the project limits. WHC will review the Form B for this property in order to respond to this request.
