Possible project areas for volunteers may include:

- Land stewardship/trail maintenance
 - o Habitat restoration, invasive species removal, trail pruning
- Aquatic monitoring
 - o Assist in water sampling and data collection from the town's many ponds
- Community events
 - o Assist with special events throughout the year promoting health and the environment
- Public Health Preparedness
 - o Help setup and run an immunization clinic
- Promote Disease Prevention
 - Lead a weekly walking group or participate in a group led exercise program
