The Cape Cod regional government, known as Barnstable County hereby ordains;

To transfer to the County's Police Academy Special Fund for Fiscal Year 2022.

Section 1.

Based on a projected budget to operate the Police Academy in Fiscal Year 22, made as of November 17, 2021, are hereby appropriated as a supplemental appropriation for Barnstable County for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, two thousand and twenty-two. Said funds are to be transferred to the Police Academy Special fund and expended to fund the activities of the Police Academy and shall be derived from Unreserved Fund Balance for FY2022. The understanding is that remaining available budgets will roll to the next period to accommodate the expected completion date of the class.





Barnstable County has enacted the following ordinances:

Ordinance No. 21-14, To amend a Portion of Ordinance 17-05 adopted by a vote of the Assembly of Delegates on May 03, 2017 and approved by the Board of Regional Commissioners on May 10, 2017, by amending the “Superior Courthouse Roof” in Section 1(b) of Ordinance 17-05 to the amount of \$210,000 and adding “Second District Roof” in the amount of \$150,000; Ordinance No. 21-15, To add to the County’s operating budget for Fiscal Year 2022, as enacted in Ordinance No. 21-06, by making supplemental appropriations for the Fiscal Year two-thousand and twenty-two; and Ordinance 21-16 To amend Barnstable County Ordinance 90-12, Chapter A: the Enabling Regulations Governing Review of Developments of Regional Impact to correct Scrivener’s/clerical errors in the document.

To amend a Portion of Ordinance 17-05 adopted by a vote of the Assembly of Delegates on May 03, 2017 and approved by the Board of Regional Commissioners on May 10, 2017, by amending the “Superior Courthouse Roof” in Section 1(b) of Ordinance 17-05 to the amount of \$210,000 and adding “Second District Roof” in the amount of \$150,000, such the amended vote reads in its entirety as follows:

The Cape Cod regional government, known as Barnstable county hereby ordains;

The following amendments are made to Ordinance 17-05, Section 1b: the “Superior Courthouse – Roof Replacement” item cost is changed from \$360,000 to \$210,000 and a new “Second District – Roof Replacement” item is added with a cost of \$150,000, and a Finance Account Number of 30180202 5840 2018 so that the amended ordinance reads in its entirety as follows:

The Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized to purchase capital equipment, and implement capital improvements for use in conducting the business of the County as follows:

Section 1.

- a. Purchase the following equipment for the Facilities Department for use in conducting business specific to the operations and services of the Barnstable County Commissioners:
