- **Wellfleet Health Department:**
  - Link to Cape Cod Healthcare heat map and MA DPH case count are on the Town website. This is how information on case counts will be shared going forward.
  - Face masks coming from Medical Reserve Corps, NRHS, and the mother of a staff member – thank you! Delivered to businesses that are open to the public.
  - 2 students from MA DPH are helping Hilary and the Town of Truro to develop a social media campaign to provide information about essential businesses and operations during COVID-19.
- **Wellfleet Police Department:**
  - Officers are getting more masks this week

- **Common Table at Fox and Crow Café**
  - 2500 meals served including to Fire and Police Department staffs
  - Staff are ServSafe certified and it is safe to obtain meals from Common Table; everyone is always wearing a mask and gloves; distancing is being exercised to greatest extent possible
- **246 Community Kitchen:** 4 freezers being donated to Wellfleet Food Pantry
- **SPAT:** purchasing and providing oysters and shellfish to kitchens throughout the Cape to serve meals
  - Providing seed money to shellfishermen/women through CDP and SPAT
