Recycle Rigid Bulky Plastics in a separate designated area

“Bulky Rigid” refers to oversized HDPE and PP items and containers. According to the APR Design Guide for Plastics Recyclability, any item over 5 gallons is considered “Bulky”. Examples include: crates, buckets, baskets, totes and lawn furniture.



Remember to REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

Reduce the use of items you don't need, especially those packaged in single-use plastic. Reuse items more than once whenever possible. Recycle items that are no longer of use at appropriate recycling centers. Together we can all contribute towards a healthier planet.
