1. Lottery drawing for grant #861/861-A
2. Public hearing re: request received May 12, 2020 from Karen D Johnson to waive one-year domicile requirement and re-issue a Commercial Shellfish License, re: Section 6.1.1 of the Shellfish Policies and Regulations.
3. Determine whether to allow seasonal recreational shellfishing permits to be sold in 2020. (Annual recreational shellfishing permits will still be sold.)

2. Lieutenant Island South Closes to Oyster Harvesting on June 1, through September 30

Area spans from osprey nest pole all the way east, and directly south across Hatch's Creek to the Eastham town line. Other areas of Lt. Island remain open to commercial harvest only, and clamming is still allowed in the Lt. Island South area.

3. Reminders:

- a. Oyster Transfers to Dealers Take Place at Marina during Vibrio Season
Transfers also allowed at Powers Landing upon notifying the Shellfish Department.
- b. Grant Inspections Will Begin Next Week with Negative Tides
This year, we will be bringing a GPS for buoy locations, in addition to the usual checks for gear height, tags and derelict gear.
