



Absentee Ballots And Early Voting For the 2016 Presidential Election

	EARLY VOTING	ABSENTEE VOTING
Who is eligible?	Any registered voters from the Town of Wellfleet.	Any Wellfleet voter who will be absent from Wellfleet on Election Day or have a physical disability or religious belief which prevents them from voting that day at the polling location.
Where do I vote?	By mail or at the Town Clerk's Office.	By mail or at the Town Clerk's office.
When can I vote?	Early voting will take place beginning Monday, October 24, 2016 and continue until Friday, November 4, 2016 .	Absentee voting will be available in the Town Clerk's office beginning Monday, October 17, 2016 during business hours of 8 am to 12 noon and 1 pm to 4pm . The deadline for absentee ballot requests is 12 noon on Monday, November 7, 2016 .
If I wish to vote in person, what are the hours?	Early voting will occur during the normal business hours of 8:00 am to 12 noon; and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm Mondays through Fridays during the early voting period (10/24/16 to 11/4/16) .	Absentee voting will occur during normal business hours of 8:00 am to 12 noon; and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The deadline for absentee ballot requests is 12 noon on Monday, November 7, 2016 .

Additional early voting sessions will also take place in the Town Clerk's Office at 300 Main Street from 4:00pm to 8:00pm on Thursday, October 27th and from 9:00am to 12:00pm on Saturday, October 29th.
